SYLLABUS - U K G

LANGUAGE

Alphabet (uppercase and lowercase), Recognising the first letter of the name of a picture, finding out the rhyming words, riddles, matching a picture with the first letter of its name, selecting the correct word for the objects from a group of words.



MONEY

Identifying coins and notes (₹1, ₹2, ₹5 and ₹10), value of money.



NUMBERS

Recognise numbers 1–100; count from 1–50; identify numbers before, after, and between; compare numbers (greater than, less than, equal to); arrange numbers in ascending and descending order.



TIME

Morning, afternoon, evening, night, reading the time on a clock (hours), daily routines.



PATTERNS

Patterns and shapes, Completing given patterns.



ADDITION

Concept of 'putting together', single-digit addition (with objects/pictures).



SUBTRACTION

Concept of 'taking away', single-digit subtraction (with objects/pictures).



ANIMALS

Wild, domestic and pet animals, birds, insects, water animals, animal sounds and animal homes, young ones, importance of animals, odd one out.



DAYS & CALENDAR

Days of the week, months of the year, concept of week, month, year, reading and understanding a calendar.



PLANTS

Types: trees, shrubs, herbs, climbers, creepers. Parts of a plant. Types of flowers: colours, shapes, smells. Fruits and Vegetables. Characteristics of climbing and creeping plants.



FOOD & HYGIENE

Healthy and unhealthy food, mealtimes and importance, good eating habits, personal hygiene, clean surroundings.



TRANSPORT

Land, water, air transport. Vehicles and their uses. Traffic rules and safety signs.



HOUSE

Rooms in a house, things in each room, types of houses, importance of home.



SPORTS

Indoor and outdoor games. Exercise and play. Team spirit and fair play.



SOCIETY

Good manners, rules at home and school, helping others, respecting elders and friends.



SPOT THE DIFFERENCES

Picture observation activities, comparing two pictures to identify missing or extra parts.



PEOPLE & OCCUPATIONS

Community helpers: doctor, teacher, policeman, firefighter, postman, farmer, driver. Tools they use, importance of each.



COLOURING

Colouring given pictures, Theme-based colouring.
