SYLLABUS - CLASS 2

LANGUAGE



Word building, selecting the right word/sentence, puzzles, riddles, rearranging words to form meaningful sentences, word/sentence completion, matching the words with suitable pictures.

SHAPES & OBJECTS



Circle, square, cone, triangle, cylinder, cube, rectangle, cuboid and sphere, objects and shapes.

CREATIVITY



Drawing, picture completion, colouring a picture.

SERIES



Series based on addition and subtraction (arithmetic series), skip counting by 3, 4, 5 and 10.

ADDITION, SUBTRACTION & MULTIPLICATION



Addition and subtraction up to 999 (3-digit numbers), multiplication up to 99 (by 1-digit number).

PLANT & ANIMAL KINGDOM



Importance of nature. Animals; birds and other living things in nature. Animals and their food habits; importance of preserving nature.

MONEY



Currency and coins, value of coins and currency (denominations), counting money, selling and buying.

HUMAN BODY



Parts of our body, internal and external organs and their functions.

TIME, DAYS & MONTHS



Reading the time on a clock, calendar- days of the week, months, year.

WATER



Sources of water, uses of water, different states of water.



FOOD & HEALTH

Different types of food, food from plants and animals, healthy food habits.



FAMOUS INDIANS

Famous Indians from various walks of life (social reformers, artists, sportsmen, writers, activists etc.).



ROAD SAFETY

Vehicles and safety rules to be followed while using them. Road safety norms, traffic signals, zebra crossing etc.



TOURIST SPOTS IN INDIA

Famous tourist spots or landmarks in India.



ENERGY

Why we need energy, various sources of energy, benefits of using alternative energy resources such as solar energy and wind energy, energy-saving measures at home.



FESTIVALS, CULTURE & HERITAGE

Cultural festivals of our country (Onam, Pongal etc.), famous arts and dance forms.



SEASONS

Various seasons in India; suitable food, clothes; weather and climate.



HOME

Different types of houses in different areas and different climates.



POLLUTION

Air, water and sound pollution, effects of pollution on humans and other living things, pollution control.



PEOPLE & OCCUPATIONS

Professions and professionals (e.g. mechanic, driver, tailor, dancer, farmer, carpenter, singer, painter).



EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

Whom to contact in an emergency, their phone numbers and other details (police, ambulance, child helpline etc.).
